Total Grant: \$307,491.00

20 % Required COVID Learning Loss Recovery: \$61,499.00

To address the impact of lost instructional time we will employ an additional paraprofessional to provide tutorials in math and reading throughout the school year for the next three years. The tutorial sessions will provide evidence-based interventions directly targeting our subgroups; including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and migratory students.

80% of ARP ESSER II Grant: \$245,992.00

The remainder of the funds from the grant will be used as follows:

Partial salary for elementary teachers allowing split classrooms for social distancing for the prevention of a COVID 19 outbreak

Custodial salary to help keep facilities cleaned and sanitized to fight the spread of COVID 19

HVAC for a high school classroom to aid in ventilation to improve the air quality and to stop the spread of COVID 19

Window replacement in the classrooms and cafeteria to improve ventilation to improve the air quality and to stop the spread of COVID 19

Expenses incurred to aid in providing internet access to our economically disadvantaged students providing them the ability to access information and complete school assignments as well as providing for socialization

Supplies for evidence-based interventions; hands on learning, phonics intervention, literacy supplies, reading and math interventions directly targeting our students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and migratory students

Cleaning supplies, gloves, masks, thermometers for extra cleaning and providing barriers to exposure to COVID 19
