

Pre-k Lesson Plans for Mrs. Barrett and Mrs. Milam for the week of May 4th-7th:

Monday, May 4th:

Reading: -Today I am learning to recognize the upper and lowercase letter Y and the sound it makes. Go to the website https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TWJSE_p0akY and listen to "The Letter Y Song". Go to the website <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o47o3b06-Xg> and sing along to the "Black Song".

Worksheet #1: (Y- uppercase Y) Trace the letter. Color the pictures, then cut and paste them in the squares. Pictures are: letter Y, Yo-yo, Yarn, and Yogurt.

Worksheet #2: (Letter Y, dab or color) Dab or color the uppercase Y and color the Y.

Worksheet #3: (Black) Color the things that are black. Trace the word black.

Math: Review the #12, sing along to "Sesame Street: 12 Little Chicks" song <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wdBzzBrzvlA> Also, listen to and count with the video "Big Numbers Song | Count to 100 Song" <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bGetqbqDVaA>

Worksheet #4: (12 Spots) Color the butterfly as desired and put 12 spots on the wings.

Tuesday, May 5th:

Reading: Today I am continuing to learn about the letter Y and the sound it makes. Go to the website https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TWJSE_p0akY and sing along to "The Letter Y Song". Go to the website <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o47o3b06-Xg> and sing along to the "Black Song".

Worksheet #1: (Yandi the yellow jacket yells.) Color Yandi, cut along the dotted lines, and find 4 pictures that start with the /y/ sound. Glue Yandi in the middle of the orange construction paper and then glue the 4 pictures around him.

Worksheet #2: (Sun Catcher - Yield sign) Yield sign made out of black dots on red construction paper. **Fine Motor Skills** - Fine motor skills refer to the coordination between small muscles, like those of the hands and fingers, with the eyes. Fine motor skills involve the small muscles of the body that enable such functions as writing, grasping small objects and fastening clothing. Get a thumbtack, nail, or something with a pointed end. Put the paper on carpet and poke each black dot on the yield sign to make a sun catcher.

Math: Listen to and count with the video "Number song 1-20 for children" <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DOAjq682yrA> Review the #12, sing along to "Sesame Street: 12 Little Chicks" song <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wdBzzBrzvlA>

Worksheet #3 - (12 Spots) Color and add 12 spots to the horse. Trace the numerals.

Wednesday, May 6th:

Worksheet #1: (Zz - uppercase Z) Trace the letter. Color the pictures, then cut and paste them in squares. Pictures are: letter Z, Zoo, Zebra, and Zipper.

Worksheet #2: (Letter Z, dab or color) Dab or color the uppercase Z and color the Z

Worksheet #3: (Letter Zz) Trace the letter Z. Color the pictures that begin with the sound of /z/. Circle each upper and lower case z.

Worksheet #4: (Zero Bees) Decorate the flower and draw zero bees on it. Trace the numerals.

Thursday, May 7th:

Worksheet #1: (Zack the zebra) Color Zack, cut along the dotted lines, and find 4 pictures that start with the /z/ sound. Glue Zack in the middle of the blue construction paper and then glue the 4 pictures around him.

Worksheet #3: (Sun Catcher Letter Z) Letter Z decorated like a zebra made out of black dots on red construction paper. **Fine Motor Skills** - Fine motor skills refer to the coordination between small muscles, like those of the hands and fingers, with the eyes.
